-Susan Aseneth was the first child born to Joseph and Susan. On Oct. 24, 1848 they had Mary Jane and on Aug. 27, 1851 Solomon was born to them. These were the only children born to Susan. (Pioneers and Prominent Men of Utah, Frank Esshom, p. 1137).

-Joseph served as a state patriarch and justice of the peace. He also helped establish the towns Parowan and Fillmore. He had five wives. (Andrew Jenson, LDS Biographical Encyclopedia, vol. 3, p.220 (1951)).
