Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? Came West with the Silas Richards Company in 1849. About 100 wagons were in the company when it began its journey from the outfitting post at Kanessville, Iowa

Any interesting facts or stories that might have been submitted.

Hyrum Smith Turley and his twin Joseph Smith Turley also died in Winter Quarters. Princetta died the same year as their mother, Sarah. Thus, the only immediate family to make it to Utah was their father, Theodore.
