Sarah Fuller, and moved to Vermont, New York and Independence, Missouri. He was a farmer and sawmill operator. Being a very religious man, he was baptized into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in March of 1838 with his family. Early Nauvoo records show he and his wife and son were living in Nauvoo by 1842 as tenants up on the hill on the north side of town. Joseph desired to accompany the Saints to Utah. He passed away in Council Bluffs, Pottawattamie, Iowa in 1846 at the age of 66.
