Online library. George Lawrence Hosmer. An historical sketch of the town of Deer Isle, Maine; with notices of its settlers and early inhabitants (p. 15) gives the following information about Chauncey Holmes and Hannah Rendell Crockett Holmes:

Chauncey Holmes, who was in his day well-known, was for many years a resident of the island, near Morse's Harbor. From what place he came, or the time of his coming, is not known to us. His wife was a Mrs. Crockett, whose maiden name was Rendell, of a family who resided in Prospect. Her first husband was Mr. Isaac Crockett . . . and they formerly lived in Vinalhaven. She had a family by her first marriage, but none by that with Mr. Holmes. He was a singular man and had a good share of wit. About the year 1843 they, with others on the island, became converts to Mormonism and removed to Nauvoo, Illinois, and when the Mormons left that place for the Salt Lake, Mr. Holmes and his wife . . . went in the company."

Hannah Rendell was the daughter of John Rendell and Jane Clark. She was married to Isaac Crockett and had the following children: Isaac, James, Robert, Nathanial, and Mary.
