Where was the family in the 1850 U. S. Census? Great Salt Lake, Utah, house #155, p.35 (Bathsheba 27, Bathsheba 8, George A. 6). George A. Sr. was living in Iron County with another wife Zilpha.

Which Pioneer wagon train took the family west? George and Dan Jones were the captains of the company that his family came with. They left Kanessville, Iowa July 14, 1849 and arrived Oct. 26-30.
